A Danish Technology firm takes a positive approach to autism--by finding them employment and harnessing the abilities that individuals with autism can bring into the workplace. "Five years in, the company now employs 60 consultants who have proven so skilled at their work they have more commissions than they can handle from multinational clients including Microsoft, CSC, Oracle and LEGO. The company's annual revenue has increased by 50 per cent year over year; by 2007, it was pulling in over \$2.3 million, and last year, the company turned a modest profit. Sonne's long-term goal is to employ 1,000-plus employees with ASDs worldwide."
